**AFFIDAVIT OF IMRE KIFOR ON THE UPDATING OF HIS MAILING
ADDRESS OF RECORD**

I, Imre Kifor, declare and state:

1. I am the pro se Petitioner in the above-captioned matter, docketed on 4/3/2026 and assigned to Chief District Judge Denise J. Casper. I make this affidavit on personal knowledge in compliance with 28 U.S.C. § 1746 to give notice that my mailing address of record has changed and to state the verifiable facts supporting the change.

2. **Updated address of record (effective immediately).** My only operative mailing address is:

3. The prior [demolished house mailbox] , Newton, MA 02464 address is now undeliverable. That structure was demolished on 2/12/2025, and the rebuild was completed just recently. Moreover, it is now listed for sale under MLS#: 73502949, apparently as of 4/16/2026. Mail directed to that address for me is not received anymore, as per the owner's request.

4. Bristol Lodge Men's Shelter is my actual physical mail intake. I have been admitted (sleep-only) to the Bristol Lodge Men's Shelter in Waltham, Massachusetts, every night since 4/1/2025. The shelter's intake confirmation (5/30/2025) is attached as Exhibit A, and corroborates the address and my forced-indigency posture.

5. The companion District Court has already adjudicated my indigency on this same record. On 3/25/2026, in the companion District Court matter (1:25-cv-11831-AK, Kelley, J.), that Court allowed my motion to proceed in forma pauperis. That adjudication establishes that my forced-indigency posture — and my reliance on a homeless-shelter mailing address — is a verified federal-court fact.

6. Prior contemporaneous verification of the Bristol Lodge address. On 12/27/2025, I executed an “Affidavit Verifying His Only Valid Physical Mailing Address” identifying the same Bristol Lodge Men's Shelter address (attached as

Exhibit B). That verification predates this docket and predates the District Court's 3/25/2026 IFP allowance, and is part of my preserved litigation record.

7. The Proposed Complaint's "Good-Faith Basis" recital is unaffected. This affidavit goes only to address-of-record administration; it does not modify any claim or assertion in the Petition for Leave or the Proposed Complaint, which I incorporate by reference. Section D of the Petition expressly states: "The Proposed Complaint is not frivolous. It presents non-trivial federal legal questions supported by documentary evidence."


8. Family Court PO-Box caveat — does not apply here. The Massachusetts Probate and Family Court does not, by general practice, formally permit PO Boxes as mailing addresses; that practice is irrelevant to federal-court service. Nothing in Fed. R. App. P. 25, the Local Rules of this Court, or 28 U.S.C. § 1746, prohibit the use of a homeless-shelter PO Box as a litigant's address of record.

9. Notice to opposing counsel. I am serving copies of this affidavit on counsel for the appellees at the addresses of record in this matter, including the Massachusetts Attorney General (Andrea Joy Campbell) and the U.S. Attorney for the District of Massachusetts (Leah B. Foley, DOJ Civil Rights), so that all future correspondence in this appeal is directed to the Bristol Lodge address.

WHEREFORE, I respectfully request that the Clerk update the docket service roster for No. 1:26-mc-91166-DJC to reflect the Bristol Lodge Men's Shelter, PO Box 541095, Waltham, MA 02453, mailing address effective immediately, and that all parties and the Court direct future service and orders accordingly.

I declare under penalty of perjury under the laws of the United States of America that the foregoing is true and correct.
